"Micro-business" means a business which is resident in Illinois, incorporated in Illinois and licensed or registered to do business in Illinois, is independently owned and operated, not dominant in its field, and employs ten or less persons.

- black: Persons having origins from any of the Black African racial groups.
- Hispanic: Persons of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Dominican, Cuban, Central or South American descent of either Native American or Latin American origin, regardless of race.
- Asian-Pacific: Persons having origins from the Far East, Southeast Asia or the Pacific Islands.
- Asian-Indian Subcontinent: Persons having origins from the Indian subcontinent.
- Native American or Alaskan Native: Persons having origins in any of the original peoples of North America.

Under Article 15-A of the Illinois Law, a WBE is a business enterprise in which at least 51% is owned, operated, and controlled by citizens or permanent resident aliens who are women.

A VBE is defined as: at least 51% of the business must be directly and unconditionally owned by one or more veteran(s) or service-disabled veteran(s) who have served in the U.S. Military.

 - Other physical improvements to processes or location to comply with social distancing or other directives issued by the County or State due to the pandemic (e.g., outdoor dining furniture)

11. The undersigned affirms that prior to submitting a grant application for the following types of expenses, the Applicant must obtain approval from the City:

12. If awarded, the undersigned affirms that no portion of the grant funds will be used by the Applicant for any purposes other than those listed in Section 10 or 11 above. Specifically, no portion of any awarded grant funds will be used by the Applicant to repay or pay down any portion of a loan obtained through a federal COVID-19 relief package for business assistance or any State business assistance programs. The undersigned acknowledges and agrees that if all or any portion of grant funds are used for any unauthorized purposes, the City may hold the undersigned, the Applicant, and/or any other owner thereof legally liable, including, but not limited to, possible charges of fraud.
13. The undersigned affirms that the Applicant is not one or more of the following types of businesses which are ineligible to receive a grant under the Program:
 (a) a non-profit organization (b) a church or other religious institution (c) a government-owned entity or elected official office (d) a business primarily engaged in political or lobbying activities (e) a landlord or other passive real estate business (f) a business or enterprise that is engaged in any activity that is illegal under federal, state or local law

The undersigned represents and warrants that no owner of greater than 10% of the equity interest in the Applicant: (a) has within the prior three years been convicted of or had a civil judgment rendered against such owner, or has had commenced any form of parole or probation (including probation before judgment), for (i) commission of fraud or a criminal offense in connection with obtaining, attempting to obtain, or performing a public (federal, state or local) transaction or contract under a public transaction, (ii) violation of federal or state anti-trust or procurement statutes, or (iii) commission of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, making false statements, or receiving stolen property; or (b) is presently indicted for or otherwise criminally or civilly charged by a government entity, (federal, state or local) with commission of any of the offenses enumerated in subparagraph (a) above.

The undersigned represents and warrants that all demographic information (to the extent the Applicant has elected to provide such information), including if applicable, information with respect to owners' socially and economically disadvantaged status, and any other information provided by the Applicant in its application regarding the ownership of the Applicant, is true and accurate.
16. The undersigned acknowledges and agrees that grants through the Program are made on a one-time-only basis. The undersigned further acknowledges and agrees that if the Applicant is selected for a grant award and receives funds through the Program, the Applicant shall not be eligible for any subsequent grant award through or under the Program.
17. The undersigned acknowledges and agrees that the Applicant's eligibility for the Program and any grant award will be determined based, in part, on the tax and other documents and information provided by the Applicant, and that the City will rely on such determination and tax and other documents in making any grant award to the Applicant.

In furtherance of the foregoing, the undersigned represents and warrants that all documentation, statements and information provided by the Applicant on and in connection with the Applicant's application under this Program are true, accurate, and complete in all material respects and that neither the Applicant nor any other authorized person on behalf of the Applicant has made or will make any material misrepresentations in connection with the Applicant's application for a grant award under this Program.
